# **Middleton Township Trustees**

Wednesday, May 15, 2019 6:30 p.m.

Mr. Vetter called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m. The Pledge of Allegiance was spoken. Trustees Bostdorff, Getz and Vetter and Fiscal Officer Limes were in attendance. The sign-in sheet for employees and visitors is attached with the approved minutes.

## FISCAL OFFICER REPORT

- Mr. Bostdorff moved, Mrs. Getz seconded a motion to approve the May 1, 2019 meeting minutes as provided. Motion approved.
- Mrs. Getz moved, Mr. Vetter seconded approval of accounts and payroll as submitted. Motion approved. A payment register is attached to the approved minutes.
- It was noted the ambulance was sold via govdeals.com and title has been transferred to the new owner.
- Mrs. Limes updated the Trustees on the Ohio Deferred Compensation program agreement.
- Mrs. Getz moved, Mr. Bostdorff seconded a motion to move forward with a website update at an estimated price of \$1,800. Motion approved.

## ROAD DEPARTMENT

- Jeff Eckel, Road Supervisor reviewed the status of roads and updates to same.
- Mr. Vetter reviewed a meeting with representatives from the City of Perrysburg with regard to repair of Five Point Road. A sewer project is pending, but it is anticipated costs will be shared.
- Mr. Eckel noted repair will be made to a township resident property on Dunbridge Road where traffic turned around due to the road closure.

# ZONING DEPARTMENT

- Zoning Inspector Jeff Ford provided a zoning report update.
- A home was torn down on River Road.
- Right of way issues have not been resolved with McCarthy Builders for Village of Riverbend Plat 3.
- Village of Riverbend Plat 5 will be place before the Wood County Planning Commission at its June meeting.
- Mr. Ford has been in discussion with Linda Holmes with regard to a variance for villas. The matter may be turned over the Board of Zoning Appeals.
- A hearing date is needed for the Board of Zoning Appeals. The Trustees encouraged the matter be resolved.
- The Zoning Commission will not have a June meeting.
- The tree line should be installed the week of May 20.
- Mr. Ford is in conversation with representatives from FirstEnergy with regard to the lights at the substation at Dowling and Mercer Roads.
- The Trustees indicated their intent to move forward with the Wood County Health District with regard to the Mansour property in Dunbridge.
