

Middleton Township Trustees

Wednesday, May 3, 2023 5:45 p.m.

Mr. Moulton called the special meeting to order at 5:45 p.m. In attendance were Trustees Cromley, Moulton, and Vetter as well as Fiscal Officer Limes. Also, in attendance was Rex Huffman and Ross Fought.

The sign-in sheet for employees and visitors is attached with the approved minutes.

Noted on the sign in sheet is a statement indicating the meeting may be recorded or streamed live to the internet by a visitor - not at the authority of the township trustees.

The purpose of the meeting is to review recommendations from the Wood County Planning Commission and Middleton Township Zoning Commission to rezone approximately 44 acres in Middleton Township from A-1 Agricultural zoning classification to M-1 Industrial zoning classification

Mrs. Limes noted the Wood County Planning Commission voted unanimously to approve the rezoning on March 7, 2023 and the Middleton Township Zoning Commission approved the rezoning by unanimous vote on April 12, 2023.

Mr. Cromley moved, Mr. Moulton seconded a motion to approve the rezoning request for approximately 44 acres from A-1 Agricultural to M-1 Industrial, owned by the Busch family. Motion approved. Role was called: Mr. Cromley – YES: Mr. Moulton – YES; Mr. Vetter - abstain

Mr. Cromley moved, Mr. Moulton seconded adjournment of the meeting at 5:50 pm. Motion approved.
