Mr. Cromley called the special meeting to order at 10:07 a.m. The purpose of the meeting was to review road bids in conjunction with the 2025 Road Resurfacing Project which includes Devils Hole Road from St. Rt. 25 to Dunbridge Road and Cross Creek Road from Hull Prairie Road to St. Rt. 64.

In attendance were Trustees Cromley, Moulton, and Vetter as well as Fiscal Officer Limes. Visitors included Kip McDowell, Zoning Inspector; Josh Belnap, Wood County Engineers' Office; and representatives from Gerken Paving, The Shelly Company, and Henry W. Bergman.

Noted on the sign in sheet is a statement indicating the meeting may be recorded or streamed live to the internet by a visitor - not at the authority of the township trustees.

Mrs. Limes opened the road bid packets in the order in which they were received at the township office.
