Mr. Cromley called the special meeting to order at 7:05 p.m. (NOTE: the meeting start time was delayed due to the number of individuals still signing in at 7:00 p.m.)
The Pledge of Allegiance was spoken. In attendance were Trustees Cromley, Moulton, and Vetter as well as Fiscal Officer Limes.
Staff and visitors in attendance are noted on the attached sign-in sheet.

The purpose of the special meeting was to review recommendations from the Wood County Planning Commission and the Middleton Township Zoning Commission with regard to two requests for rezoning.

Mrs. Limes read the legal notice for the special meeting with regard to rezoning as published in the Sentinel-Tribune on August 27, 2025.

Kip McDowell, Zoning Inspector, provided the Trustees with two separate letters from the property owners who have requested rezoning from A-1 Agricultural to M-1 Light Industrial. Each letter stated intent to withdraw the rezoning request effective Monday, September 8, 2025. The two properties in question include: approximately 75 acres owned by Eckel Trustees and approximately 37 acres owned by Speck Trustee.

Mr. Vetter moved, Mr. Moulton seconded a motion to accept the requests to withdraw the rezoning requests by the Eckel Trustees and Speck Trustee. Motion approved.

Mr. Vetter stated there was no further business that could come before the Board.

Mr. Moulton moved, Mr. Vetter seconded a motion to adjourn the meeting at 7:08 p.m. Motion approved.
